We had our ninth batch of students take the Secondary School Certificate examination this year. What made it glorious was the grand success at the examinations...our students did us proud. A 100% success, ninth time in a row, with 36 of the 78 students appearing having scored above 90%. Dhruva Upadhye topped the school with 98.40%, Apoorva Rajadhyaksha was second with 96.80% and Anjaneya Mulekar third with 96.60% .

Last year Ananya Sharma represented the school at the Mumbai Level in the English Elocution Competition organized by **Forum of Free Enterprise** in January 2019. It gives me immense pleasure to announce that Ananya Sharma stood first in Mumbai, winning a prize money of Rs. 10000/-. Her topic was "Honesty and hard work- hallmarks of a Sportsperson." The current edition of this competition is on and Rama Ranade of Std X is representing our school for the all Mumbai level.

### **MATHS**

Our alumna Apoorva Rajadhyaksha secured the **National Talent Search Scholarship** and will be felicitated on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2020 by the Government of Maharashtra. She also bagged the state scholarship and was ranked first in the **Maharashtra Talent Search Examination**.

Avanish Dhapare of Std IX was ranked 8<sup>th</sup>. Anushka Kulkarni and Varun Madkaikar of std IX stood 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> respectively and were awarded the **District Scholarship**.

Our students appeared for the Mathematics Concept Examination where the success rate has been commendable...of the 30 Std V students who appeared, 17 scored 70% and above. Dhruv Umarji scored 100% and was first in Mumbai, Netra Pandit scored 92% and was second in school. Disha Dhonthula and Rammya Sabnis scored 92%. Of the 13 students from Std VIII who appeared, 10 cleared the examination with 4 students scoring 70%. Ayush Patil scored 90% and was first in school followed by Rajeswari Mitra and Ojas Yadav scored 84% and 74% and stood second and third respectively.

To foster a spirit of true competition, we invited the panels of judges who are experts in their field. The Recitation competition and the Handwriting competition were held in a highly competitive atmosphere where each student participated and the winners were selected after various rounds of elimination. The Elocution competition for Std IX and X had the Forum of Free Enterprise as our collaborators and had judges of repute. This year Rama Ranade the winner, will represent BalmohanVidyamandir for the Mumbai Finals.*

<b>Girls</b>	<b>Badges -</b>	The School badge is to be worn one inch below the neck line in centre on the tunic and the house badge one inch below it.

The Student Council Badge is to be worn in lieu of the House badge an inch below the school badge. The Student Council consists of all the Prefects, Vice-Captains, Captains, Assistant Head Girl and Assistant Head Boy and the Head Girl and Head Boy.

**Scout Uniform :**  
**Boys and Girls**

The Scout scarf is to be worn on the predefined days as per instructed. The Scout scarf is to be held together with the Scout Woggle. The Scout uniform is complete with the School cap on which the Scout badge is pinned. Student to report to School in complete School uniform on all occasions unless otherwise specified.

School & House badges not to be worn on P.T. Uniform.

**PLEASE NOTE :**

1. All Students are expected to attend School in regular Uniform every day and in P.T. Uniform on days specified by the School.
2. Identity card is to be worn every day to School and on all field trips / picnics / excursions / workshops.
3. Boys should have closely cropped hair. Fancy hairstyles are not allowed.  
Girls with long hair should tie up their hair neatly. No fancy accessories are permitted by the School.
4. Finger nails must be cut short and kept clean. Nail paint or Mehendi is not permitted.
5. Prior permission to be taken from the Principal before applying Mehendi (After permission Mehendi can be applied only upto the wrist).
6. Students should avoid wearing gold jewellery to School. The School is not responsible for the loss of any valuable article when the child is in the School.  
Use of fancy and long earrings, bangles and chains, etc is not permitted.
7. Students should wear their tie in a double knot. For boys the length of the tie should reach the trouser belt.
8. Girls should wear their sash in a single knot to the left hand side.
9. Student studying in Std VIII to X are permitted to wear Analog wrist Watches. Digital and Sports Watches are not permitted. Watches should have simple straps either leather (brown / black) or metal (steel).

## STEP BY STEP TUTORIAL HOW TO TIE A DOUBLE KNOT TIE



1. The wide end "A" should extend about 12 inches below narrow end "B". Cross wide end "A" over narrow end "B".



2. Bring wide end "A" up through loop between collar and tie; then back down.



3. Pull wide end "A" underneath narrow end "B" and to the left, and back through the loop again.



4. Bring wide end "A" across the front from left to right.



5. Pull wide end "A" up through the loop again.



6. Bring wide end "A" down through the knot in front.



7. Using both hands, tighten the knot carefully and draw up to collar.

**Students are required to adhere to the above Uniform Regulations.**

**RECOMMENDATIONS TO PARENTS**

1. **HANDBOOK MUST BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL EVERYDAY AND HANDLED WITH CARE. PUPILS SHOULD NOT USE THE HANDBOOK FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN SCHOOL WORK.**
2. Parents and guardians are reminded that their help and co-operation is of great significance in the efforts made to mould the child's character in School. They are therefore earnestly requested to encourage regularity and discipline in children. They should regularly see that their children prepare the home assignments and come to School in proper uniform with all the books required for the day's work.
  - i) Parent shall ensure that the Cell Phones are placed on Silent / Vibration Mode in the School premises.
3. Parents are requested to leave their wards at the entrance of the School 10 minutes before the School begins. Regularity & Punctuality is expected from students at all times.
4. Minimum attendance of 75% of the total number of School days is required to be fulfilled by all students.
5. If a pupil has some contagious disease, the Principal should be informed as soon as possible and the pupil must not be sent to School until the period of infection is over.
6. Leave of absence for upto 2 days should be intimated to the Class Teacher through the Handbook itself. In case a child remains absent for a longer period on medical grounds, a

medical certificate along with the covering letter should be submitted and the School should be informed at the earliest.

7. Personal hygiene and cleanliness are expected of all students.
8. Parents are requested to give the required doses of immunisation to their wards.
9. The Parent's signature in the Handbook would indicate that the remarks entered by the School authorities have been noted. **They are requested to go through the Handbook daily.**
10. Parents desirous of meeting the Teachers regarding the progress of their wards may do so only by prior appointments through their ward.
11. Parents are requested to refrain from sending anything (lunch-box, note-books, parcels etc.) to the children through the reception / Office.
12. Any change in residential address or telephone numbers should be immediately communicated to the School authorities.
13. The students are not allowed to carry cell phones or any other electronic gadget to School.
14. Parents should not send any sweets or presents for distribution on the birthdays of their wards.
15. Parent meetings shall be conducted as and when necessary. Parents are requested to attend these meetings without fail.

They should ensure that they are dressed appropriately suitable for the decorum and atmosphere of an Institution of learning.

16. **School buses are not owned by the School and are on contractual basis. However, the parents can avail of the bus service, if necessary.**
17. Parents are to refrain from using unauthorized bus services or commercial carpools. This is to ensure the safety and security of our students.

27. In the interest of your wards security, Parents / Guardians entering the School premises must carry the entry pass provided by the School. In case someone other than the parent picks up the child, he / she will have to carry the entry pass along with him / her as a mark of identification.
28. All electronic communication will be sent on the student email. **Parents are requested to check the mails regularly.**  
  
In case of any queries with regards to the student email, please contact the School Office.
29. Except under exigencies, students are expected to attend the School for the entire day. No request for leaving early will be entertained.

30. 'Friday Lunch Menu' must be strictly adhered to.
31. Attendance is mandatory for the students of Std VIII, IX & X on Independence Day and Republic Day.
